RULES & REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE TEAM & DOUBLES NO-TAP TOURNAMENT

(PLEASE DETACH AND RETAIN THIS PORTION OF ENTRY BLANK)

- USBC Rules shall be observed. **THIS NO-TAP TOURNAMENT IS CERTIFIED BY USBC.**
- No-Tap Tournament. When you knock down 9 or 10 pins on your first ball - it's scored a strike. All other scoring is the same as in regulation play.
- Teams will consist of 5 bowlers. Any combination of men and women.
- Doubles teams will consist of two bowlers, any combination of men and women.
- All bowlers must be USBC certified, valid 2010/2011 season. USBC youth members are ineligible to bowl in this tournament. **Associate memberships can be purchased prior to participation. The cost is \$21.00 or pay participation fee of \$5.00. (CAPTAINS SHOULD BE PREPARED TO SHOW MEMBERSHIP CARDS AND AVERAGE VERIFICATION UPON CHECK IN AT EVERY SQUAD.)**
- AVERAGES**
- Use highest **certified** league average based on a minimum of 12 games for the 2009-2010 season unless rule 5g applies.
- If no average last season, use highest current season **certified** average based on a minimum of 12 games as of March 1, 2011.
- USBC Youth Averages **will not be accepted.**
- 5d. No Summer League averages will be accepted.**
- All others will bowl scratch 220.
- Use of current season average as per Rule 5b, shall require written verification from league secretary upon check-in.
- If current season average determined according to Rule 5b is 10 pins or more higher than previous season's average, then the higher average must be used. (minimum of 12 games)**
- AVERAGES WILL BE VERIFIED. Average corrections must be made within 48 hours after completion of bowling.** Failure to do so during this time period shall disqualify score, if submitted average is lower than actual average. See USBC Rule 319 a-3 and 319 a-4.
- Rule 319e is waived in this tournament.
- Bowlers with a Sport Bowling average only must submit the adjusted average as per rule 202 a-d. Bowlers with both a Sport Bowling average and a standard average, must use the higher of the standard average or the Sport Bowling average adjusted as per rule 202 a-d.
- TEAM EVENT HANDICAP**
HANDICAP: 90% based on 1100.
MAX HANDICAP: 400 pins per game
- In Team event, teams over 1100 team average can bowl but will receive 100% negative handicap. Based on 1100 team average.**
- DOUBLES EVENT HANDICAP**
HANDICAP: 90% based on 440.
MAX HANDICAP: 160 pins per game.
- In Doubles event, doubles teams over 440 team average can bowl but will receive 100% negative handicap. Based on 440 doubles team average.**
- All decimal points will be dropped.
- Teams and doubles will be randomly assigned to lanes. Requests for pairings must be submitted with entry blank, at least two days before your scheduled date. **No guarantees will be made.**
- Line-ups must stay the same as on submitted entry blank.
- Tournament director reserves the right to reject or rerate any entry.**
- Any rerate or average adjustment, whether accepted or refused, and/or disqualification by any tournament (certified, noncertified, or TV show) must be reported.
- Bowlers who fail to report any of the above prior to bowling may be disqualified, forfeiting all tournament fees and winnings. Declaration must be complete, in writing, in ink, signed and dated by declaring bowler. (Forms are provided)
- Tournament management has the right to adjust scores after bowling should verified average or other pertinent information become available that was not available at time of check-in.
- PBA members of standard or full membership status must have a verifiable league average in accordance with no-tap rules (See rules 5a thru 5j).
- USBC Rule 319d, amended to 18 month period, **applies to ALL entrants** - Tournament winnings over **\$300.00** must be declared.
- Multiple Participation - Not more than 3 bowlers on the same team can place more than once in the prize list.
- In the Doubles Event. Re-entry allowed but must change partners or with the same partner, can place only once in the money.
- Prize Ratio - At least one prize for each ten teams, or better.
- All prize fees returned 100% - **Prize money will not be paid until all averages are verified.**
- It is the **Captain's responsibility** to have all team members' averages verified if team places in the prize list.
- All games must be bowled at the time scheduled. No grace period or postponement allowed. Tardy bowlers receive zero score for any frames missed.
- All teams will bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Please observe 1 lane courtesy. Total score plus handicap for the three games will determine the final score.
- All substitutions must be approved by the Entry Acceptance Committee, and in making substitutions the committee must be notified **one hour** prior to the time the team is scheduled to bowl. Failure to do so may result in rejection of the substitute bowler.
- If a substitution is made during practice, the substitute must complete the first game and any other games currently in progress.**
- If the house provides a substitute bowler, captains will be responsible for entry fee. Jackpots are the responsibility of the substitute bowler.
- All claims in connection with scoring errors must be made within 1 hour after bowling.
- ENTRY BLANKS MUST BE FILLED OUT COMPLETELY OR WILL BE RETURNED TO THE CAPTAIN. INCOMPLETE ENTRY BLANKS MAY DELAY CHECK-IN AND PRIZE PAYOUT.**
- Instant jackpot, win \$40.00 cash on the spot.**
Jackpot No. 1 - Averages up to 179 must bowl 270 or better.
Jackpot No. 2 - Averages 180 and over must bowl 300.
All Jackpots are \$5.00 to enter.
Jackpot may only be hit once per bowler per squad.
- Walk-in Entries will only be accepted until 1/2 hr. before squad time, if lanes are available.**
- Tournament Committee reserves the right to request photo identification from any participants at any time.**
- Tournament Committee may require a photograph of all entrants, placing in the top five positions of any category of our prize list, immediately upon their completion of bowling. Captains should refer to our current standings board following participation to see if this rule applies to their entry. If so, the entire team must report directly to tournament headquarters. Failure to present yourself for a photograph at this time may result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fee and prize winnings.
- At the Tournament Committee's discretion, a photograph of any participant may be taken immediately upon his/her completion of bowling. Failure to comply will result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fee and prize money.
- Tournament Committee reserves all rights.**
- Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency, or emergency causes relating thereto or therefrom, fire, natural disaster, or any other reason beyond the control of South Side Bowl No-Tap Tournament shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
- Squad organizers will receive 1 free five person team entry on each squad where they enter 10 or more five person team entries. Squad organizers will receive 2 free doubles entries on each squad where they enter 20 or more doubles teams. Total prize money collected and awarded as prizes will be based on the total of all paid entries and any free entries awarded under this rule. **Jackpots will not be included in free entries.**

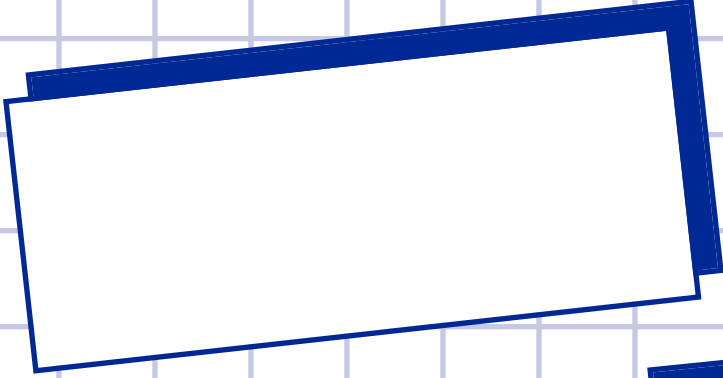
